Day 1 Arrival

Arrive Edinburgh or Glasgow Airport collect hire car and travel to your accommodation. This will be a farmhouse situated at the foot of the Pentland Hills in a picturesque rural location only 23 miles from Edinburgh.

Day 2 Scottish Borders/Edinburgh

Enjoy visits today in the area - New Lanark Heritage Centre is close by as are the Scottish Border towns of Selkirk, Galashiels and Melrose, or give the Scottish capital Edinburgh a visit. Return to farm, for overnight accommodation.

Day 3**Royal Deeside & Grampians**

Depart from Edinburgh and travel north into the Scottish Highlands. Travel via and Perth and north over the beautiful Grampian Hills. You will pass Glenshee, one of Scotland's ski resorts. Drop into Braemar, a lovely Highland town and at the heart of Royal Deeside. Visit Balmoral Castle, the Highland Residence for the Royal Family. Continue to your accommodation overnight.

Day 4**Whisky & Castle Trail**

Enjoy a day in this lovely area of Scotland. Visit Fyvie Castle, Crathes Castle or Duff House which houses some of Scotland's finest art works. Alternatively, visit one of the many whisky distilleries in the area where you will be given a tour of the distillery followed by a small tasting. If time allows, you could take a boat trip out onto the Moray Firth and see if you can spot dolphins.

**Day 5****Loch Ness – Great Glen – Fort William/Oban**

Depart Morayshire and travel to Inverness along the banks of Loch Ness famous for its monster, Nessie. Follow the Caledonian Canal down into the Fort William/Oban area. If the weather is good, take the gondola up to Anoch Mor where there is a mountain café and great views of the surrounding countryside including across to the Isles. Continue south-west to the Fort William/Oban area where you will overnight.

Day 6**Isle of Skye or Isle of Mull**

This morning explore the local area, or take a trip by ferry to one of Scotland's many islands. The Isle of Mull is a 1 hour ferry journey from Oban, which is 20 minutes by car from your farm. The journey by ferry across the Sound of Mull is spectacular and well worth the effort. Alternatively, visit the Isle of Skye – either by taking the ferry from Mallaig to Armadale or crossing the bridge which runs from Kyle of

Lochalsh across to Kyleakin. Return to farm for overnight accommodation.

Day 7**Glencoe, Stirling, Loch Lomond**

Today depart from your accommodation and travel south via Glencoe, a beautiful and historic valley where the MacDonald Clan were slaughtered by the Campbell Clan. Visit the excellent visitor centre which will tell you the story as well as explain about the local geology and wildlife. Continue to Stirling where you can visit the Castle which has been at the heart of much of Scotland's turbulent history. Or take a boat trip out on the beautiful Loch Lomond – Scotland's longest fresh-water loch. Check-in to your accommodation overnight.

**Day 8****Departure**

Journey back to Edinburgh or Glasgow airport for your flight.
